WASTE ACCEPTANCE CRITERIA

DEBRIS TREATMENT(ENCAPSULATION)

- To meet the definition of debris, waste needs to be 60mm in size or greater
- Debris needs to be at least 50% of the waste
- For EPA Hazardous Waste Codes D004-D011, no analysis or sample is required

STABILIZATION/THERMAL

- A sample (approx. one gallon) of waste will need to be sent to US Ecology prior to receiving material. A recipe development will be completed on sample.
- Once waste stream is approved US Ecology will need to test the recipe on the first two loads before receiving any additional loads
- For *stabilized* waste, analysis may be required to verify organic concentration is less than 500 ppm

WASTE MEETING TREATMENT STANDARDS

- Analysis will be required to demonstrate that the waste meets all applicable LDR treatment standards.

NON-RCRA/NON HAZARDOUS

- Generator Knowledge
- Unused/Off Spec Material, a MSDS may be required

All waste streams that are profiled to **US Ecology are co-approved by the State of Nevada.**

Upon receipt of your waste stream approval number, you must contact US Ecology to schedule the arrival of your material. **PLEASE SCHEDULE AT LEAST 48 HOURS IN ADVANCE, SO THAT THE UNLOADING OF YOUR MATERIAL WILL NOT BE DELAYED AT THE FACILITY.**
