SOLID WASTE DISPOSAL AREA OPERATING LICENSE

Effective April 22, 2019, the Michigan Department of Environmental Quality, by Executive Order Number 2019-06, became the Michigan Department of Environment, Great Lakes, and Energy (EGLE). Effective April 22, 2019, the Waste Management and Radiological Protection Division became the Materials Management Division (MMD).

This license is issued under the provisions of Part 115, Solid Waste Management of the Natural Resources and Environmental Protection Act, 1994 PA 451, as amended, MCL 324.11501 et seq., and authorizes the operation of this solid waste disposal area (Facility) in the state of Michigan. This license does not obviate the need to obtain other authorizations as may be required by state law.

The licensee shall comply with all terms of this license and the provisions of Part 115 and its administrative rules. This license includes the license application and any attachments to this license.

1. The licensee shall operate the Facility in a manner that will prevent violations of any state or federal law.
2. The attached map (Attachment A) shows the Facility, the area permitted for construction and/or placement and acceptance of waste, and the following, if applicable: monitoring points, leachate storage units, site roads, other disposal areas, and related appurtenances.
3. Issuance of this license is conditioned on the accuracy of the information submitted by the Operator/Applicant in the Application for License to Operate a Solid Waste Disposal Area (Application) received by EGLE on April 8, 2019, and any subsequent amendments. Any material or intentional inaccuracies found in that information is grounds for the revocation or modification of this license and may be grounds for enforcement action. The licensee shall inform EGLE's MMD Warren District Supervisor of any inaccuracies in the information in the Application upon discovery.
4. This license is issued based on EGLE's review of the Application, submitted by US Ecology Michigan, Inc., for the



8. The licensee shall conduct hydrogeological monitoring in accordance with the approved hydrogeological monitoring plan, dated NA (see Special Conditions). The sampling analytical results shall be submitted to EGLE's MMD Warren District..
9. Modifications to approved engineering plans that constitute an upgrading, as defined in R 299.4106a(e), may be approved, in writing, by EGLE's MMD Warren District Supervisor.
10. **SPECIAL CONDITIONS:**
 - a. The applicant shall report any fire incidents at the Facility to EGLE and Wayne County Department of Environment immediately.
 - b. At the time of issuance of this license, the applicant is not required to conduct groundwater monitoring at the Facility based on the evaluations presented in the "Hydrogeologic Report," revised September 2008, prepared by Earth Tech AECOM, and the fact that all solid waste processing operations will be conducted in an enclosed building with a properly sloped/contained concrete floor. EGLE may require groundwater monitoring in the future if there is reason to believe that the Facility may be causing groundwater contamination.
 - c. If the licensee is granted authorization under the provisions of Part 111, Hazardous Waste Management, of the Natural Resources and Environmental Protection Act, 1994 PA 451, as amended, MCL 324.11101 et seq. (Part 111), to store and/or treat hazardous waste within the solid waste disposal area authorized under this license, then the licensee shall revise the existing Part 115 Operations Plan (approved with Solid Waste Disposal Area Construction Permit Number 4098 issued on October 14, 2008,) to address the storage/treatment of hazardous waste and submit it to the MMD for review and approval. The revised Part 115 Operations Plan must describe the waste screening, segregation, testing, and/or decontamination procedures that will be used to ensure that the treatment residuals generated at the Facility are managed and disposed in accordance with Part 115 or 111, as applicable.
11. **TERM:** This license shall remain in effect until its expiration date, unless revoked or continued in effect, as provided by the Administrative Procedures Act, 1969 PA 306, as amended, or unless superseded by the issuance of a subsequent license.
