The solid waste processing facility permit renewal application for EQ Industrial Services, Inc and Shipwreck, LLC, is approved. You, the permittees, must comply with Indiana's rules for solid waste processing facilities (329 IAC 11) and the terms of this permit.

EQ Industrial Services, Inc. is a solid waste processing facility (facility) that receives non-hazardous waste for consolidation and bulking. The facility consists of a one-story building and a depressed dock ramp for storing waste, and a fenced, asphalt paved area for roll-off containers.

The facility has approximately 2.17 acres approved for processing. It is located at 2650 North Shadeland Avenue, Indianapolis, Indiana.

This permit expires on **February 5, 2027**. To operate past this date, you must submit a renewal application on or before **October 6, 2026**.

Public records for your facility are available in IDEM's Virtual File Cabinet at <https://vfc.idem.in.gov/>. Documents related to this approval include the permit renewal application dated February 24, 2021 (VFC #83121314); additional information dated June 21, 2021 (VFC #83172444) and August 11, 2021 (VFC #83204630); and previous submittals dated March 24, 2010 (VFC #64971717) and February 12, 2018 (VFC #80614170).

Please note, as permittees for this facility and the land upon which it is located, you are liable for any environmental harm caused by the facility (329 IAC 11-11-4(3)(b)).

If you do not comply with the requirements of this permit, IDEM may modify or revoke this permit (329 IAC 11-11-6) or initiate an enforcement action.

You can review the Indiana Code (IC) and the Indiana Administrative Code (IAC) references in this document at iga.IN.gov. IC references are under the "Laws" link. IAC references are under the "Publications" link.

This permit does not: convey any property rights of any sort or any exclusive privileges; authorize any injury to any person or private property or invasion of other private rights or any infringement of federal, state, or local laws or regulations; or preempt any duty to comply with other state or local requirements (329 IAC 11-11-4(a)).

If you wish to appeal this decision, you must file a request for administrative review with the Office of Environmental Adjudication within the following timeframes:

1. If you received this notice by email, you must file the request within 15 days of the date IDEM sent the email.
2. If you received this notice by U.S. mail, you must file the request within 18 days of the notice postmark date (15 days from the date IDEM mailed the notice, plus 3 days because the notice was sent via U.S. mail).

The enclosed Notice of Decision notifies you of additional important details regarding the appeal process and your rights and responsibilities for filing an adequate and timely appeal.

Your attention to the requirements for managing, containing, and disposing of waste protects public health and the environment in your community.
