On June 6, 2018, the Michigan Department of Environmental Quality (MDEQ), Waste Management and Radiological Protection Division (WMRPD), conducted a financial record review (FRR) of the April 15, 2018, Hazardous Waste Certificate of Insurance provided by Great American Insurance Company on behalf of US Ecology, Inc. (USE) to demonstrate financial assurance for closure and postclosure care at Wayne Disposal, Inc. (WDI) located at 49350 North I-94 Service Drive, Belleville, Michigan.
