I have made the name change in our computer system.
This is to notify you of your USDOT Identification number and to draw your attention to the requirement for Marking of Motor Vehicles in Section 390.21 of the Federal Motor Carrier Safety Regulations. A copy of the marking rule is enclosed. Its primary purpose is to assist enforcement personnel in properly identifying motor carriers. A medical examination is also required every two years on a specific form and card, that may be obtained from one of the sources on the attached list. There is no need to return completed medical exams to this office. Please retain them in your office. This is a requirement for truck and bus drivers.

If you are operating as a private or for-hire motor carrier of property or passengers, in interstate commerce, this regulation requires you to mark all of your trucks or buses in accordance with the enclosed marking rule. The following USDOT NUMBER is assigned to the motor carrier identified above:

USDOT 157372

The USDOT NUMBER above is the one that should be displayed on your truck, bus or limousine.

NOTE: This is a company number - one number for all your trucks, buses or limousines. There is no need to reapply for any more USDOT numbers if you get new trucks or buses.
