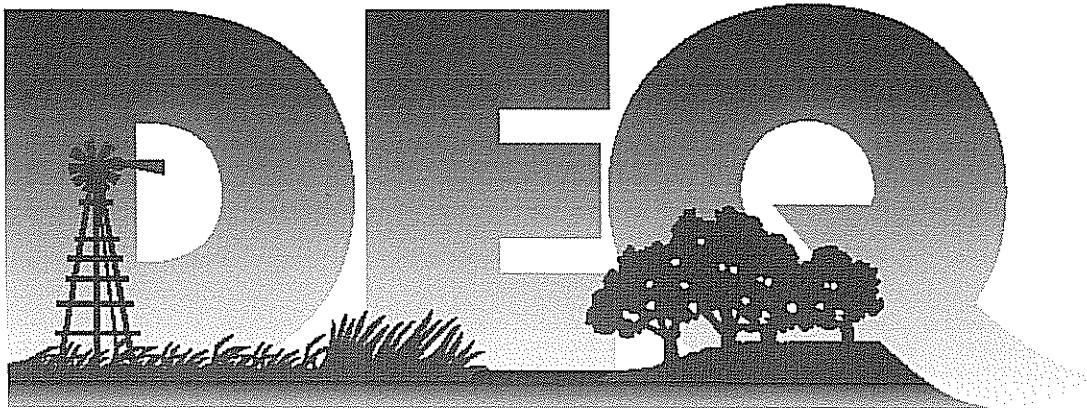

Pursuant to the Solid Waste Disposal Act (as amended by the Resource Conservation and Recovery Act (RCRA) of 1976, and the Hazardous and Solid Waste Amendments of 1984 (HSWA) at 42 U.S.C. § 6901 *et seq.*), and regulations promulgated thereunder by the U. S. Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) codified in Title 40 of the Code of Federal Regulations, the Oklahoma Hazardous Waste Management Act (OHWMA) at 27A O.S. § 2-7-101 *et seq.*, and rules promulgated thereunder in OAC 252:4 and OAC 252:205, a Class II Tier II Operations Permit is renewed and reissued by the Oklahoma Department of Environmental Quality (DEQ) to EQ Oklahoma, Inc. (Permittee) for the facility located at 2700 South 25<sup>th</sup> West Avenue, Tulsa, OK 74107, at latitude 36.122414 North and longitude 96.020344 West. The legal description of the facility is:

A tract of land that is all of the north half of the southeast quarter of the southeast quarter of the southwest quarter (N/2 SE/4 SE/4 SW/4) and all of the northeast quarter of the southeast quarter of the southwest quarter (NE/4 SE/4 SW/4) and part of the southeast quarter of the northeast quarter of the southwest quarter (SE/4 NE/4 SW/4), all in section fifteen (15), township nineteen (19) north, range twelve (12) east of the Indian Base and Meridian, Tulsa County, State of Oklahoma, according to the U.S. Government Survey thereof, said tract of land being more particularly described as follows:

Beginning at a point that is the southeast corner of said N/2 of the SE/4 of the SE/4 of the SW/4; thence S 88° 49' 53" W along the southerly line thereof for 660.74 feet to the southwest corner of the N/2 of the SE/4 of the SE/4 of the SW/4; thence N 01° 09' 45" W along the westerly line of the E/2 of the SE/4 of the SW/4 and along the westerly line of the SE/4 of the NE/4 of the SW/4 for 1267.08 feet; thence N 88° 50' 15" E for 177.20 feet; thence N 02° 36' 30" E for 227.70 feet; thence S 63° 51' 34" E for 208.33 feet; thence S 23° 05' 22" E for 102.00 feet; thence S 30° 43' 31" E for 47.33 feet; thence S 86° 34' 35" E for 223.71 feet to a point on the easterly line of the SW/4 of said section 15; thence S 01° 06' 59" E along said easterly line for 1244.97 feet to the point of beginning of said tract of land.

This document evidences a decision by the DEQ to issue a Permit renewing the operating ability of the Facility for a period of ten (10) years. This Permit may be renewed if all applicable conditions have been met.

The Permittee must comply with all terms and conditions of this Operations Permit (Permit). The Permit consists of the conditions contained herein (including those in any attachments), the

applicable standards and the general facility conditions developed in accordance with the OHWMA, and the provisions contained in 40 CFR Parts 260 through 279 and 124, as specified in the Permit. Applicable State and Federal regulations are those which are in effect on the date of issuance of this Permit, in accordance with 40 CFR § 270.32(c). In the event of any inconsistency or conflict between the DEQ-prepared text of this Permit and any submittals or other attachments incorporated by reference, the DEQ-prepared text of this Permit shall prevail.

This Permit is based on the assumption that all information submitted in the Part B Permit Modification Application as modified through April 19, 2011 (Application), is accurate and that the facility will be operated as specified in the Application.

Any inaccuracies found in the submitted information may be grounds for the termination, revocation and reissuance, or modification of this Permit in accordance with 40 CFR § 270.41, 270.42 and 270.43, and for enforcement action. The Permittee must inform the DEQ of any deviation from or changes in the information in the application that would affect the Permittee's ability to comply with the applicable regulations or Permit Standards and Conditions.

This Operations Permit is effective from January 9, 2013, and shall remain in effect until January 9, 2023, unless the Permit is revoked and reissued under 40 CFR § 270.41, terminated under 40 CFR § 270.43, or continued in accordance with 40 CFR § 270.51, and applicable Oklahoma statutes and rules.
