in accordance with effluent limitations, monitoring requirements and other conditions set forth in Parts I, II, and III, hereof.

The above-referenced facility is authorized to retain wastewater in one (1) total retention (T01) impoundment as described in the Appendix. Direct discharge of wastewater from impoundments T01 to waters of the state is specifically prohibited. Surface impoundments shall be maintained in accordance with Parts I, II, and IV hereof.

Issuance of this permit in no way or in any respect affects the permittee's civil or criminal responsibility regarding disposal of wastewater, except with respect to the permittee's legal responsibility under the OPDES Act and Department Rules.

This is a modified Permit and shall replace permit OK0045578 that went into effect May 1, 2018.

This modified permit shall become effective on June 1, 2018.

This permit and the authorization to discharge shall expire at midnight, on April 30, 2023.

This is to certify that the wastewater discharges set forth in this permit comply with the requirements of Oklahoma's Water Quality Standards, as amended, provided the permittee does not exceed the effluent limitations set forth in this permit.
