Enclosed is combined Hazardous Waste Permit Number 34875-HO-013 and Solid Waste Permit Number 34875-SO-014 for the continued operation as a solid waste and hazardous waste storage and treatment facility, with modifications as listed on the permit application and including corrective action requirements under the Department's authorized program for implementing/continuing the federal Hazardous and Solid Waste Amendments (HSWA). When the permit is final, any party to the permit has the right to seek judicial review of the permit pursuant to Section 120.68, F.S., by the filing of a Notice to Appeal pursuant to Rule 9.110, Florida Rules of Appellate Procedure, with the Clerk of the Department in the Office of General Counsel, Department of Environmental Protection, 3900 Commonwealth Boulevard, MS #35, Tallahassee, Florida 32399-3000; and by filing a copy of the Notice of Appeal accompanied by the applicable filing fees with the appropriate District Court of Appeal.

Pursuant to authorization obtained by the Florida Department of Environmental Protection (FDEP) under the Resource Conservation and Recovery Act [42 United States Code (U.S.C.) 6901, *et seq.*, commonly known as RCRA] and the Hazardous and Solid Waste Amendments of 1984 (HSWA), this permit is issued under the provisions of Section 403.722 Florida Statutes (F.S.), and Chapters 62-4, 62-160, 62-701, 62-730, 62-701, 62-777 and 62-780 Florida Administrative Code (F.A.C.). This permit replaces expired Hazardous Waste Permit 34875-HO-012 and Solid Waste Permit 34757-SO-010. The above-named Permittee is hereby authorized to perform the work or operate the facility shown on the application dated October 13, 2018. Three extension requests were requested with the final submittal due date of April 8, 2019 and supplemented on April 9, 2019 and April 11, 2019 that are incorporated herein and collectively referred to as the "permit application". The Solid Waste Application was revised on October 3, 2018. Two extension requests were requested with the final submittal due date of March 4, 2019 and supplemented with information on March 26, 2019 and April 8, 2019 that are incorporated herein and collectively referred to as the "permit application." The permit application also includes any approved drawing(s), plans, and other documents that are specifically identified and incorporated by reference. Solid waste management units (SWMUs) and areas of concern (AOCs) identified to date are listed in Appendix A. The RCRA-regulated units permitted units or permitted activities are specifically described as follows:

Increase capacity of permitted container storage area within the Waste Processing Building (WPB)

Increase in currently permitted storage capacity of 80 drums or a maximum capacity of 4,400 gallons to a maximum storage capacity of 4,950 gallons of hazardous waste (waste codes D002, D004 through D011, and K062) for up to 365 days.
