



COVID-19 Visitor Access Instructions

(References: *US Ecology's Level 1 and 2 Coronavirus Outbreak Response Plans*)

Requirements and Prohibitions

- All Drivers/Delivery personnel who can perform duties without leaving the cab of their vehicle are required to do so.
- All parcel and mail deliveries must be left outside the entrance of all facilities (as practicable). US Ecology personnel must sanitize outside surfaces of all parcels and packages prior to bringing them inside of facilities.
- A US Ecology representative is expected to interact with all visitors to obtain status information. Phone or Radio correspondence is preferred. In-person questioning is OK provided appropriate social distancing requirements are met (minimum of 6-feet).
- If "Yes" responses are received for any of the following questions, visitors will not be allowed access to US Ecology facilities:
 - If you or someone that resides with you exhibits symptoms including fever (100.4 F or higher), cough, shortness of breath.
 - If you or someone that resides with you were knowingly exposed to someone that tested positive for coronavirus or that exhibit symptoms of coronavirus.
 - If you or someone that resides with you travelled by air, bus, train or cruise within the past 5 days.
- All visitors requiring entry into US Ecology facilities must submit to a body temperature scan using a touch-free infrared thermometer. All individuals exhibiting signs of a fever (100.4 F or higher) will not be allowed access to US Ecology facilities.

General Guidance and Precautions

- Minimize time on site as much as possible. Do not enter any buildings or structures without USE prior authorization.
- Practice social distancing protocols at all times, allowing a minimum of 6-feet spacing between other persons whenever possible. Do not shake hands and avoid personal contact.
- Please clean your hands often with an alcohol-based hand sanitizer that contains at least 60-95% alcohol or wash their hands with soap and warm water for at least 20 seconds. Soap and water should be used preferentially if hands are visibly dirty.
- Please do not touch your face, eyes, nose or mouth. If you must touch them, wash your hands first. Ideally the only time you should touch your face is with soap to wash it and only then with clean hands.
- Do not bring food to eat while on a US Ecology site unless specifically authorized by management.
- Please wear nitrile or equivalent gloves when exchanging paperwork or other goods. Gloves can be provided if necessary.
- Sanitize your mobile phone using 60% minimum isopropyl alcohol wipes (or with similar hand sanitizer) or a bleach solution on a regular basis.
- Routinely clean all frequently touched surfaces in the workplace and in vehicles including keyboards, mouse, doorknobs/handles, seat belts, control knobs, latches, and other often-touched parts and surfaces contacted daily. Use a sanitizer/disinfectant known to kill viruses.
