US Ecology Williston TSDF (permitted as ENPRO Services of Vermont, Inc.) is a fully licensed, RCRA Part B, TSCA certified TSDF specializing in drum, lab pack and household hazardous waste transfer and consolidation.

The facility is permitted to store up to 2,353 containers (55-gallon drums) of hazardous waste for a maximum time of one year. All containers of hazardous waste are profiled for acceptance into the facility and stored inside in a climate-controlled secure area with chemically-resistant, concrete-coated bays.
